Hybrid – This model is available for students who are home because they are ill or quarantined. It will also be used if we need to reduce the number of students in the building each day and go to a plan where ½ of the students come one day and the other ½ come the next. If this happens, classes will run like "normal" for students in the building. Students at home will receive an invite from their teachers to Google Meets, allowing them to log in during the designated times to participate in their classes. Teachers will also record the sessions and share the link to these for students who are unable to attend.
